	1. AAA: analyze variation in threshold diameter for elective repair, including center volume and economic influences (add more recent year's data available for Vascunet in mid-2017).	
	2. AAA: compare in-hospital mortality of open vs EVAR treatment of ruptured AAA using 2010-2016 data, comparing trends over time and differences in men/women.	
	3. Carotid: analyze variation of interval from symptoms to treatment across countries.	
	4. Comparison of outcomes that don't require risk adjustment: In cases of prophylactic treatment of small AAA, asymptomatic carotid, and claudication patients, the decision to recommend treatment implies an assessment of risk, such that risk adjustment for key outcomes is not needed.
